What is an archive?

The word archive can be used to describe both collections of material and the facilities where those materials are preserved.

The materials archives collect and preserve are primarily in a controlled environment that controls temperature and humidity, which is referred to as a climate controlled environment. Materials are preserved with care so they can be used long term for research.
