

Career Consular Officials  
Out of State Tuition Differential Waiver

The Career Consular waiver may be granted to a student or their spouse and dependents who are on assignment under government orders in Georgia on a foreign diplomat personal visa living in Georgia. The student must be lawfully present in Georgia. The waiver must be renewed every 12 months provided the student is still eligible for the waiver.

Students will have until 30 days after the first day of the term to apply for this waiver. No applications will be accepted past that date. No retroactive changes will be considered for prior terms or fiscal years.
